## Annual Bulky Waste Clean Up Day 2019

Moring Disposal will be providing the annual Bulky Waste Clean-Up Day for all homes in the City of Fulton each year on the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday in October.

**Program Date: Saturday, October 5, 2019.** *All acceptable bulk waste should be set at the curb the night before or by 6:00 a.m. on the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday in October. Items set out after the truck has passed will not be collected. Trucks will not be in alleys for the bulky item pickup. Participating residents must place clean up items out front or on the side at the street, whichever is most convenient.*

**Waste Collection Limit:** Each participating residence may set out up to two (2) large bulky items and one (1) cubic yard of miscellaneous waste (six 35-gallon garbage containers).

**Program Guidelines:** Miscellaneous bulky waste should be contained in bags or boxes. Uncontained items will not be collected. Large appliances, electronics, and construction material are prohibited. The following are detailed lists of acceptable and unacceptable items.

### ACCEPTABLE (BULKY)

Couches  
Sectional - (limit (1) full sectional)  
Sleeper sofas  
Rocker/recliners  
Coffee/end tables  
Kitchen tables  
Bed frames  
Mattress/box springs  
Baby beds (cribs)  
Bicycles  
Swing Sets (Broken down to max 4 ft.)  
Dressers, shelving, cabinets etc.  
Push mowers (Fuel & oil must be drained)  
Microwaves

### ACCEPTABLE MISC. ITEMS

Boxes or cans of small items including:  
Bikes, tricycles, outdoor toys, lawn tools,  
grills, lawn chairs, baby swings, playpens,  
walkers, car seats, fans, dishes, clothing,  
vacuum cleaners, pillows, picture frames, area  
rugs, etc.

### UNACCEPTABLE (BULKY)

Major appliances  
Electronic Items (TV's, computers, monitors,  
printers, faxes, DVD players, VHS players, etc.)  
Air conditioners  
De-humidifiers  
Water heater/softener  
Windows  
Plate glass  
Riding lawn mowers  
Tires  
Demolition/remodeling debris  
Cement, rock, brick  
Carpeting  
Car parts

### UNACCEPTABLE MISC. ITEMS

Electronic Items (Cellular phones, mp3  
players, radios, etc.)  
Auto batteries  
Liquid waste of any kind  
Household hazardous waste  
Medical waste  
Solid steel posts  
All heavy gauge steel  
Yard waste
